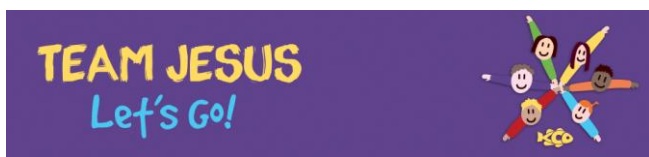

Introducing Rev Lindsay Faulkner OAM

Lindsay Faulkner, the youngest in his family, describes himself as Tasmanian even though he grew up and attended high school in Box Hill Victoria and worshipped at The Avenues Presbyterian Church in Blackburn. Significant in Lindsay's growing up experience were his mother and a returned ANZAC.



Lindsay's first job was in Alice Springs where he joined the John Flynn Memorial Church and was inspired by the passion for ministry of a Padre in the Methodist Inland Mission. On coming to Adelaide, Lindsay joined the congregation at Adelaide Central Mission where he was led into a deeper understanding of the faith and it was from this congregation that Lindsay candidated for the Methodist Ministry.

About this time, he met and fell in love with Nessie who became his wife and his strong supporter, companion and friend in ministry in many placements, including State Immigration Chaplain in Wynyard Tasmania, UCA representative on the Executive of the Victorian Council of Churches, Moderator of the Northern Synod, and Superintendent of the Port Pirie Central Mission.

Rotary awarded Lindsay the Paul Harris Fellowship in 2002 and he received the Order of Australia Medal in 2006.



Retired from active ministry and residing at Felixtow, Lindsay and Nessie's passion for God's mission is exercised through their ministry in Payneham Road UC and in the Uniting Church Adult Fellowship, Lindsay being the newly commission President.

Lindsay's theme for the two years of his presidency is ***the Bond of fellowship***, building on the words of Paul when he shows how ***the Bond of fellowship*** includes ALL. In 1 Corinthians 12:12ff Paul wrote about the Body of Christ having many parts all bonding and working together. So we, though many, are Bonded into One fellowship in Christ.

Lindsay reminds us that the Uniting Church Adult Fellowship is an agency of our National Assembly – the words used at its commissioning being 'Uniting Church Adult Fellowship (UCAF) is an agency and includes ALL adult members of the church'. It's his conviction that all members of congregations are included under the umbrella of the UCAF whether they are in an affiliated group or not.
